**CLOSING DATE AND SCRATCH POLICY**

**ENTRIES CLOSE WEDNESDAY MARCH 14 AT 11:00 P.M.** Entries will be accepted on line, via mail, phone or fax until 11:00 p.m.. No entries will be accepted after that time. Please be aware that other on line

systems may have an earlier close date, and that it is the responsibility of the other entry systems to comply with the ACC closing time and date. Fees must accompany entries. Please mail **one entry form for each dog for each stake** entered. A full refund of entry fees will be made for dogs withdrawn before the draw, and after the draw **with a veterinarian's certificate** for dogs injured, ill, deceased, or for bitches in season. All other scratches for **REASONS CONSIDERED VALID BY THE FIELD TRIAL COMMITTEE** will be refunded up to **one half** the entry fee, **provided the scratch is given to the Secretary PRIOR to the beginning of the stake** in which the dog is entered. Please note: Dogs and bitches will be mixed in all stakes. Bitches will be subject to check. The Dow Jones Index will determine the initial running order of the Special and Amateur All Age stakes. The judges may impose a system of rotation in the Special and Amateur All Age stakes.

**FIELD TRIAL ENTRY WEB SITE:** We are using a computer system which will allow you to enter your dogs via the internet.

There are two payment options: mailing entry fees along with your signed entries, or using a Visa, Discover or Mastercard credit card on line. There is a service charge per entry when using the credit card option. To use the system, enter your dogs by logging on to

**FIELD TRIAL GROUND INFORMATION:** *All persons entering the area, 16 years and older, who do not have a valid California hunting, fishing, or trapping license, or California Wildlands pass will be required to purchase in advance a Daily Use Fee Pass through the Automated License Data System. Passes are available for \$4.32 on line through <http://www.dfg.ca.gov/licensing/landpass/> or in person at licensing agencies. Each person is required to register daily at the registration booth at the entrance of the area. There will be a posted exercise area. **THERE ARE NO TRAINING AREAS ON THE GROUNDS. PARKING IS IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. VEHICLES MAY NOT BLOCK ROADWAYS***

**ADDITIONAL INFO:** The function of this club is to conduct its field trials according to the AKC rules and procedures, as fairly and expeditiously as possible. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the handler of each competing dog to have the dog available at the proper place and time for testing. Handlers sharing transportation and running in conflicting stakes are expected to arrange for transportation to enable the dog to run at the proper time. .

**DIRECTIONS TO FIELD TRIAL GROUNDS:**

FROM STATE HWY 152: Turn north onto Mercey Springs Road/Hwy. 165  
Turn right onto Henry Miller Road, and follow 1.5 miles to the Refuge located on the left.

FROM INTERSTATE 5: Henry Miller Road Exit EAST 10.8 miles (total). Turn left at Volta Road.  
Turn IMMEDIATELY right onto Henry Miller (again). Follow 1.5 miles beyond the intersection of Hwy. 165. Turn left into the refuge.
